Triton College Updates

Triton has been approved as a candidate for the Accreditation Council for Business Schools and Programs. This process will grant accounting and business programs accreditation which is given to a small number of community colleges. This will be very appealing to businesses and transfer universities.

Dr. Griffins explained the certificate/course changes scheduled at Triton. Triton is also looking into a Conflict Resolution course and Health Administration course.
