1. Dual Credit Status

- a. Val reviewed the process for dual credit. Due to the licensing issues, classes in allied health will need to be taught on the Triton campus by Triton faculty.
- b. Val also reviewed the process for becoming an adjunct faculty member at Triton.
- c. The following courses are available for dual credit at Triton
 - i. AHL100 – Introduction to Patient Care
 - ii. AHL102 – Ethics and Law for Allied Health
 - iii. AHL103 – Basic Pharmacology for Allied Health
 - iv. NAS100 – Basic Nursing Assistant
 - v. NAS101 – Care of Patients with Alzheimer's
 - vi. EYE 100, 101, 105, 110, 120, and 130

2. Leyden's Medical Careers Course

- a. We discussed the possibility of adding Triton as a site for the Leyden Medical Careers course.
- b. Ideally, students would observe a lab setting at Triton and possibly a group discussion on Triton's course offerings.
- c. We also discussed the possibility of Triton staff discussing entrance requirements, financial aid, etc with the medical careers' students.
