## **Tech Share Workshop**

We reviewed the evaluations from the Tech Share event held in March and determined that the event was vey successful. The 18 participants scored the event with an average of 10 out of 10 with very positive comments.

Lauren Martire and Amy Gorzynski of Leyden were particularly effective in demonstrating the myriad ways we could use Google Apps in our classrooms. In addition, Brian Davis of OPRF presented other ideas of ways to use Google in the classroom. Marcia Bernas presented some tech tools as well. A favorite part of the day was favorite lesson and apps shared by all the participants. The strong consensus was to continue Tech Share next year although we prefer a date in February.
