Lesson 2

Your Task

To design a [monochromatic](#) site about a topic of choice.
This topic MUST be school appropriate.

Requirements

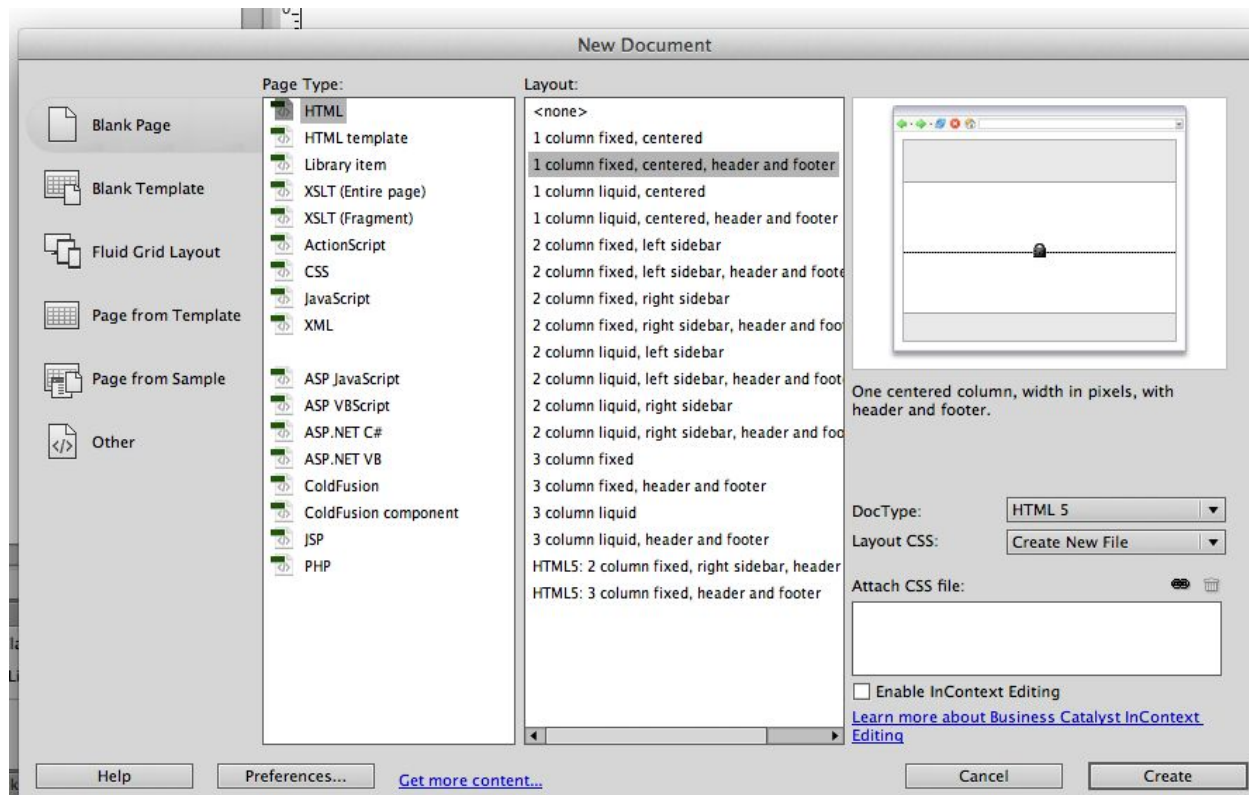
4 page website **minimum** – more if you'd like

Required Elements

- o Use the [Adobe Color Wheel](#) to find your perfect color
- o Use a number of tints and shades of that color to “scatter” through your site
- o 1 ordered list
- o 2 graphics (give the proper attribute and link to where you got each one if it is not yours)
- o Demonstrate your knowledge of design principles: user-friendly, easy to read, easy navigation, links to proper pages/urls, and site balance.
- o No spelling or grammar errors
- o Information about the topic you chose - use your own words here -
DO NOT COPY AND PASTE ANYONE ELSE’S WORDS.

Setting Up Your File - read this very carefully

- o Create a folder “lastname_color” in your personal drive
- o There should only be one other folder inside: images. This is where you will store photos used in your site. All images need to be downloaded and stored in this file.
- o All other pages and resources should be saved in the “lastname_color” folder - we will get to this part later.
- o Open Adobe Dreamweaver.
- o Click on “create new HTML”
- o Choose “File”, then “New”
The following image shows up:



- o Select the layout that you would like (keeping everything else the same)
MAKE SURE IT SAYS “HTML 5” in the DOC TYPE DROP DOWN
MAKE SURE IT SAYS “ CREATE NEW FILE” in the Layout CSS DROP DOWN
- o Click on “Create”
- o Next, it will ask you to create a css sheet

- o Name it “color.css” and make sure you put it in your “last name_color” folder, click “SAVE”.
- o IMMEDIATELY, “save as” your work and name it “index.html” and save it in your folder.

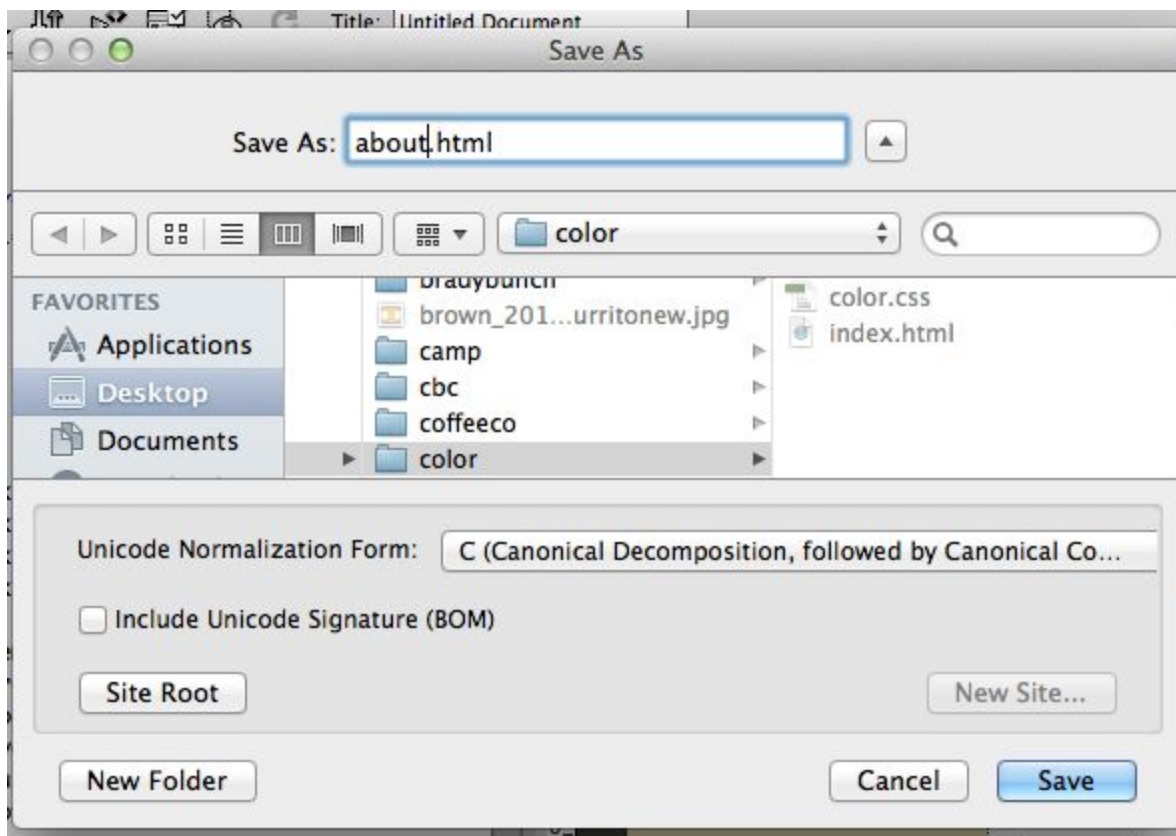
Start Designing!

Don't forget to go to "SITE"->"New Site" so you can access your images and html pages in your files panel.

Once you have your home page the way you like, you are ready to create the other three pages.

Each page needs to have a name:

- o about.html - what the website is about
 - o photos.html – either personal photos or photos from another site (remember to give proper attribution to photos that do not belong to you)
 - o contact.html - this is where visitors can contact you
- o All you have to do is choose “File”, “save as”. When the box comes up, just rename the page as the new one (make sure to keep it in your last name_color folder.)



- o You will do this for the other pages you create. All you have to do is **keep the navigation bar the same** and change the content for each page.
- o Once you complete your site, zip your folder and upload it to the dropbox.
