

Illinois Lic Requirements for Secondary PEL/CTE

All CTE Licenses require 2,000 documented work-related hours in industry. PEL/CTE require approved coursework as follows:

Business, Marketing, and Computer Education (171) test	Business, Marketing and Computer Education – Business Computer Programming (6-12) 24 semester hours with 12 at the upper division 9 of the 24 hours in Business Computer Programming
Family and Consumer Sciences (172) test	Family and Consumer Science - Apparel and Textiles 24 semester hours 9 of the 24 hours in Apparel and Textiles
Family and Consumer Sciences (172) test	Family and Consumer Science – Living Environments 24 semester hours 9 of the 24 hours in Living Environments
Family and Consumer Sciences (172) test	Family and Consumer Science – Nutrition, Wellness, and Hospitality 24 semester hours 9 of the 24 hours in Nutrition, Wellness, and Hospitality
Technology Education (174/219) test	Technology Education (Industrial Arts) (6-12) 24 semester hours with 12 at the upper division
Computer Science (038) test	Computer Science (6-12) 24 semester hours with 12 at the upper division NOT a CTE Lic. Must apply for ELS/CTE Lic in Programming CIP
