Chicago Women in the Trades

Sheena Brewer and Cindy Conner spent most of the meeting discussing their programs in Chicago Women in Trades. Our committee found this to be extremely beneficial. We learned they have two different programs that are both 12 weeks (Construction/Manufacturing and Welding). The construction program can help females in our schools, get into the union. Students must have a high school diploma or GED and be 18 or older to start the program. They have classes two nights per week and on Saturdays. Classes are at 16th and Western in Chicago and have 4 different start times per year. Classes are anywhere from 28-35 students. They will come to Career Fairs and speak to students at individual schools.

Connections Conference--March 6th and 7th

Conference will be in Tinley Park. Traditionally schools have had money to send counselors. Each school will check with their admins to see if money is there to pay for registration. As of now, none of the student services committee is registered to attend.

Surveys
