II. Conference Update

Leyden - Attended South by Southwest - huge education conference in Austin, 4 business teachers went. Sessions included technology, ELL, student certification, basically all things education.

Elmwood Park - Attended METC in St. Charles, Missouri. - Tech Apps in the classroom was the main focus. STEM and CTE was highlighted and there were many breakout sessions that were attended.

Also attended ACTE - Lots of technology related breakout sessions and learned a great deal of curriculum related information to bring back into the classroom.

Proviso - Attended the IBEA in Springfield. Attended many sessions that will help to modify curriculum to ensure students are meeting the needs of employers and college/career readiness.

Also attended the Connections Conference in Tinley Park and just got back from the CTE Showcase in Springfield (see most recent DVR Dimensions newsletter).

Triton College - Triton is doing assessments for the entire college. Gretchen is part of the team who writes new curriculum. They are working on getting their department certified by the Accreditation Council for Business Schools and Programs - a special certification. This will take place April 14-16th. It is a 4 year process where the organization goes through the classes and teachers' credentials to ensure the teachers and classes are up to standards. End of June they will know if the department becomes certified.

Oak Park River Forest - Attended the Connections Conference in Tinley Park and

the CBEA. Many workshops and breakout sessions attended to bring back into the classroom and modify assessments.

Ridgewood High School - will be attending an Incubator workshop this summer, along with a Mobile Makers workshop.

Riverside Brookfield High School - Attended the Connections Conference. Brought back great information from McHenry school district on implementing a business model into graphic design and construction classes. Also presented a session on gamification.

Also attended the IBEA in Springfield. Learned a lot about the dark web and how it works. Also, went to a session on bitcoins and how it relates to our students AND investing. Thinking we might want this topic as the "star" for next year's Tech Share.

III. Non-Traditional Programs/Activities

Women and Tech day at Leyden

Counselors set up a couple of activities in many of our districts.

IV. Math Integration in CTE

Ridgewood - Math and business class Algebra II in Business - block period 2 teachers up to 50 students - year three. Kids are running their businesses and selling for profit. Six Flags has a business day for students. Offer gift cards to kids \$15-19 per kid. Luca's school has dual credit - 30 kids are going into incubator next year. Going to start for sure next year.

Offering us to visit Ridgewood to shadow the math and CTE curriculum in April.

Proviso - Geometry in Construction.

Business concepts and technology and Computer Applications are year courses.

Riverside Brookfield High School uses business math in Accounting and Web Design. Algebraic equations are used in Game Design.

The ISBE College and Career Readiness was passed out to all attendees.

Looked at college and career readiness - talked about attendance and how students check in - every teacher includes grading for attendance in their class.

Ridgewood looking at alternate attendance and participation in order to meet the 95% attendance requirement.

How do we motivate our reluctant learners to come to school everyday?

Some Illinois schools do NOT grade on attendance. Ridgewood grades the skill not the absence.

Triton - gets three points a day for attendance.

Talked about eLearning - Pros/Cons. We also talked about our experiences with eLearning this year.

Career Readiness Indicators were discussed and we wondered how the state is going to track each student's requirements.

VI. Dual Credit

A. All of Ridgwood's dual credit will be next year - Needing 10 years of experience or 2800 hours? Will find out the hours instead of having a

Master's.
