Harry had to cancel coming to our meeting due to illness. He said he will be attending the January 24 meeting.

Program Completion Discussion:

The group was asked by Anne to discuss if we could find out reasons why students start and don't finish programs, and any ideas to help get them to finish. Some ideas the group up with:

- Have an exit survey for students--figure out their reason why they didn't continue (i.e. money, opportunity, change of mind, time of the program, etc.)
- Are there certain programs where the program retention is better than others? What kind of things can be taken from that?
- Are we talking about high school programs or college program completion?
- At the college level, are there advisors from the specific programs who work with students through the whole process?

Building Updates:

We discussed what buildings do regarding placement and if a student wants to level up or level down compared to what is recommended. It is interesting to see how all schools do things a little differently.

Ridgewood stated they will be doing more Cohorts next year. Currently they have cohorts in Auto, Criminal Justice, Education, Trades/Manufacturing, and are adding a few more. Elmwood Park has partnered with TCD for cohort programs. Students can go to TCD in the morning or afternoon and go to EP the opposite time frame.

Dual Credit Updates:

There have been updates to the online application and live now. There is a proposed changed to the placement exam requirement, not requiring dual credit students to have to take this test. This is hopeful to begin in fall of 2020. Registration right now has already surpassed last years numbers.
