- Local Needs Assessment Survey: Resent the survey to the group and gave a few minutes to fill it out. Sent it back in January for those looking for the email from me.
- Budget Requests: Discussed If our committees would like to have regional budgets available for activities to support career development and our programs of study, including teacher professional development in FY21 ((For example, this year Student Support Services visited an Apprenticeship Center - a visit they had requested for FY20 in the prior spring.)
  - a. Ideas presented: Would like certification trainings: Suture skills, Lifting patients (lots of basic skills they learn in cna)
  - b. Career Development: Students getting a chance to explore all of the careers and program options somehow.

      - 2. American Hip institute is new partnership but only 3 students go at a time
      - 3. Brainstormed solutions to how to get kids in the hospitals to see the careers
      - 4. Advisory Committee needs assistance with these partnerships from DVR**
