#### **Local Needs Assessment**

Sarah Wurster attended our meetings to break this down for us. There are many items in the local needs assessment that are counselor specific. Since Sarah is very familiar with the document, she is going to break down the parts that specifically pertain to counselors and go over those parts with us at our October 16th meeting. Some things she highlighted in our meeting included that we need to prove to the state that we are doing everything in the needs assessment. She said we need to start tracking kids beyond high school, make sure students are completing career assessments, enrolling kids in CTE classes, enroll kids in dual credit, keep track of meeting with students, have advisory committees in areas of CTE, etc. Sarah stated we are doing many of these things already, just need to have the formalized. We look forward to the Oct 16 meeting to learn even more about this.

## **Building Updates:**

All the counselors were updating on their current teaching model (i.e. remote, hybrid), etc.

## **Triton Updates:**

Advisors goal is the academic work (get the kid in school) and counselors are emotional support (keep the kid in school). They are using career coach, a new career exploration tool. Currently 70% of their classes are totally remote. Lab classes are currently meeting. Library is open. Counselors and advisors are seeing kids virtually. Ken sent information on two upcoming days and clarified the high school day is a full campus tour and meeting with admissions, while the virtual days are meeting with different programs that are highlighted.
