## Paul Hoetzer, Chicagoland Laborers Training and Apprentice Fund

#### Requirements:

- Birth Certificate
- 18 years or older
- Social Security Card
- Photo ID
- High School Diploma, GED, or transcript showing completion of 10<sup>th</sup> Grade

**Entry Process:** Contractor must hire candidate and complete a Sponsorship application on Laborers' website. Contractor will make a good faith effort to employ hired candidates for 2 years.

**Additional Information:** All new hires are required to join the Laborer's Union. **Openings:** Year-round, with contractor sponsorship via Training Fund's Website.
